Before a student is enrolled in a Utah public school, the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must show proof of residency in the school district which the student desires to attend.

The following documents shall be used in determining residency:

All items must show current address. The following do not establish residency: Powers of attorney Property owned in school district boundaries Letters from friends or relatives P.O. box in school district boundaries
